DAY 1

DAY 4

We begin our day with a ferry ride to the **Statue of Liberty** and nearby **Ellis Island**. We will also visit the **National Museum of Immigration**, where we’ll learn the earliest history of New Amsterdam, the original name of New York. Our bus then returns us to our hotel.

DAY 5 L

Another day of fantastic **guided touring** with Marta takes us uptown. Lincoln Center, the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, Columbia University, are just a few of the sites we’ll see as we travel to and from Harlem. Back in Manhattan, our afternoon walking tour includes Rockefeller Center, the neo-gothic-style **St. Patrick’s Cathedral**, and a **tour of Radio City Music Hall**.

DAY 6

We enjoy an additional free morning to discover the unique aspects of this city before enjoying another spectacular Broadway performance.

DAY 7

After checkout, we are headed to Grand Central Terminal. The **Metropolitan Museum of Art** is the final stop on our Big Apple adventure, then we’re off to the airport for our flight home.
