



## **PALO DURO CANYON**

June 14 – 15, 2020 (2 Days)

Across the high plains of eastern New Mexico and the Texas panhandle is a true hidden treasure. Palo Duro Canyon, just outside Amarillo, is the “Grand Canyon of Texas”. The state park encompasses over 42 square miles of beautiful vistas and trails and is home to *Texas!*, “the most spectacular outdoor musical drama in the world.”

### **DAY 1            L**

We’re off to the heart of the Texas Panhandle, and the second-largest canyon in the country, [Palo Duro Canyon](#). Before arriving, we have lunch in an unusual place – Glenrio, New Mexico.
